Day 1 / Arrive Salt Lake City, Utah

Travel to Salt Lake City today, with your arrival time depending on your departure city.

Little America Hotel or similar

Day 2 / Salt Lake City

After breakfast, tour Salt Lake City, site of the 2002 Winter Olympics. You'll visit Temple Square, world headquarters of the Mormon Church. Marvel at the awesome Tabernacle, dedicated in 1893, and famous for its amazing acoustics and Mormon Tabernacle Choir.

Day 3 / Salt Lake City • Jackson Hole, Wyoming

This morning, depart for Jackson Hole, Wyoming, stopping along the way at scenic Bear Lake on the border of Utah and Idaho, where you'll have time to seek out lunch on your own. Arrive in Jackson Hole later today, where you'll enjoy an included dinner.

Day 4 / Jackson Hole • Snake River float

Depart this morning for Snake River, where you'll enjoy an included float tour. Wind your way through the gentle waters of the

Snake River corridor, granting you a unique look at the unspoiled wilderness and unique wildlife of Grand Teton National Park, keeping an eye out for elk, moose, falcons, eagles, and more.

After your river experience, the rest of the day is at leisure.

B—Snow King Resort Hotel or similar

Day 5 / Jackson Hole • Yellowstone National Park • West Yellowstone, Montana

Today, you'll depart for Yellowstone, passing through the gorgeous mountain scenery of Grand Teton National Park. Enter Yellowstone through its South Entrance

and enjoy your first of three included tours of America's oldest National Park. Your route takes you by Lewis Lake, the thermal pools of the West Thumb Geyser Basin, Old Faithful, and more. Lunch is included during your tour.

Arrive late this afternoon in West Yellowstone.

B,L—Best Western Desert Inn or similar

Day 6 / West Yellowstone • Yellowstone National Park

Spend the day exploring Yellowstone National Park, America's first national park and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and home to 60 percent of the world's geysers.



Your itinerary continued

See the park's numerous geothermal features such as hot pools, fumaroles (smoke vents), and geysers, including Old Faithful. And keep your eyes open for some of the park's famous wildlife, including grizzly bear, elk, fox, wolf, and bison. Dinner is included tonight.

B,D—Best Western Desert Inn or similar

Day 7 / West Yellowstone • Yellowstone National Park • Cody, Wyoming

This morning, set out upon your third and final tour of Yellowstone National Park as you make your way east toward Cody, Wyoming. Enjoy an included picnic lunch in the park and take in a few more of its notable sights, including the Mud Volcano Area to see its impressive cluster of hot springs and mud pots, and the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone—a magnificent canyon carved out by the thundering falls of the great Yellowstone River.

Day 8 / Cody • Buffalo Bill Center of the West

Begin your discoveries today by reflecting upon a controversial chapter of American

history during an included tour of Heart Mountain Relocation Center, the site of a former Japanese-American internment camp. The complex is currently a museum dedicated to recording the experience of the inmates who lived out the war here—including those who resisted the draft after it was extended to interned Japanese Americans in 1944.

After your visit to the camp, you'll tour the Buffalo Bill Center of the West, widely regarded as one of America's finest Western museums.

B,D—Holiday Inn at Buffalo Bill Village or similar

Day 9 / Cody • Sheridan

Travel to Sheridan today, enjoying an included lunch and basking in the majestic scenery of the Bighorn Mountains as you ride. Stop en route for a moment of quiet reflection at Little Bighorn Monument, then arrive in Sheridan later today.

B,L—Best Western Sheridan Center or similar

Day 10 / Sheridan • Devil's Tower • Rapid City, South Dakota

Travel through the Black Hills of Wyoming and South Dakota today, stopping along the way for an included tour of Devil's Tower.

This 1,267-foot monolith was established as the first national monument in 1906 by President Theodore Roosevelt. Continue on to Rapid City, arriving in the late afternoon.

B,L—Holiday Inn Rushmore Plaza or similar

Day 11 / Rapid City • Badlands National Park

This morning, tour Badlands National Park, a preserve of centuries-old fossil beds, rugged landscapes, and mixed-grass prairies. The park's geological formations range from jagged ridges to ethereal spires, with changeable contours that vary with weather and time. Enjoy lunch on your own during a visit to Wall Drug, a roadside shop launched during the Depression and made famous for offering free ice water. Today, it's a compendium of Old West, Native American, and South Dakota memorabilia. Return to Rapid City, for time at leisure and dinner on your own.

B—Holiday Inn Rushmore Plaza or similar

Day 12 / Rapid City • Crazy Horse Monument & Mount Rushmore

Begin your discoveries of South Dakota's legendary Black Hills with a sightseeing tour of Rapid City. Visit the Crazy Horse Monument, a mountain sculpture-in-progress honoring the Native American leader. Continue on to witness famous Mount Rushmore, where each of the four presidents' heads is as tall as the entire Great Sphinx of Egypt.

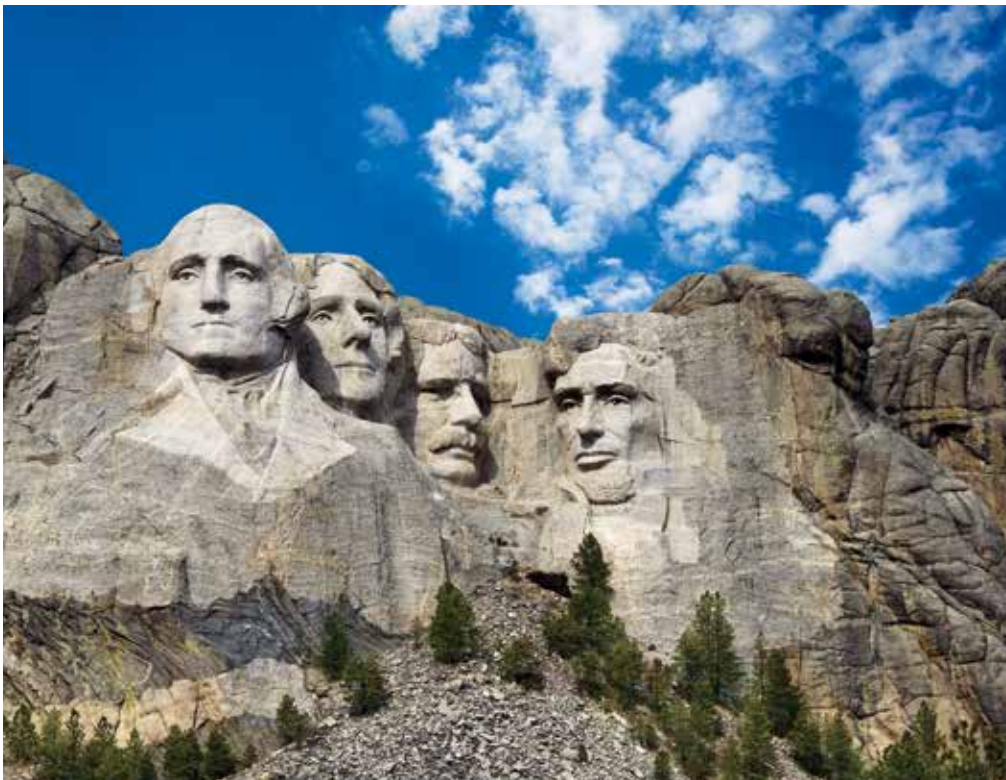
